**Session 1: Portraits and Personality, Fabric & Textiles**

**June 5-16, 2017**



Students will study the portraiture of Pablo Picasso, Frida Kahlo and Joan Miro and create their own personal journal and sketchbook. Students will also learn about Elizabeth Keckley, dressmaker to first lady Mary Todd Lincoln. Students will explore various types of fabrics and create designs, clothing or art using textiles.

**Session 2: Claymation, Puppet making, and Making Art, Music and Dance that Tells a Story**

**June 19-30, 2017**



In this session students will experiment with flipbooks, storyboards, stop motion animation and puppet making. Students will also explore music of various genres that tell a story through rhythm, beat, melody, lyrics, and African, Hawaiian and other dance movements.

### **Session 3: Tribal Art, Plant & Flower Art**

**July 3-14, 2017**


(Closed Tuesday, July 4)



In session three students will investigate Native American, Polynesian, African and Aboriginal traditional art methods and the use of symbolism. Students will also learn about the Japanese art of ikebana (flower arranging) and the work of Georgia O'Keeffe while creating their own plant art in watercolor and ink, printmaking and sculpture.

### **Session 4: Three-dimensional Art, Architecture, Fashion and Industrial Design**

**July 17- 28, 2017**



Students will study the work of Cles Oldenburg, Louise Nevelson and Carole A. Feuerman and experiment in three-dimensional artwork. The second week of this session, the children will explore Architecture, Fashion and Industrial Design and explore careers in art by creating architectural models, mood boards for a fashion collection and car concept sketches. We will discuss sunglass designers, Coco and Breezy, Tesla's Franz von Holzhausen and our neighbors Porsche in this session as well!
